We joined the Sacramento County Office of Education for a tabling event focused on connecting with educators, program leaders, and school-based staff. It gave us the chance to highlight the services *Wind Youth* provides, answer questions directly, and make sure the people who interact with youth every day know where to turn when a young person needs safety, support, or basic resources.

We also participated in a countywide gathering that brought together elected officials, city leaders, and other community decision-makers to address homelessness collaboratively. *Wind Youth* was there to represent the needs of young people experiencing homelessness and to ensure that youth-specific resources were part of the conversation. Our presence helped reinforce that young people deserve a seat at the table when solutions are being built.
